

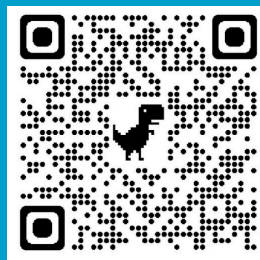

Who would benefit from RYLA?

Rotary and the RYLA team see leadership potential in young people from all backgrounds, not just those who have previously held leadership roles. We want to hear from young people who are open to challenging themselves.

We encourage applications from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, the LGBTIQ community, and people from culturally diverse backgrounds.

The RYLA Program aims to:

- Help you gain a better understanding of your own strengths, passions and values;
- Develop your leadership skills through experiential workshops, involving teamwork, communication, motivation and introspection;
- Foster an appreciation of the diverse abilities and unique qualities of other around you;
- Provide an opportunity for you and other young people to come together in a supportive environment;
- Develop a set of resources and tools to facilitate the your ongoing development in the community;
- Create a greater awareness of social issues affecting young people;
- Demonstrate Rotary's commitment to young people.



Program Details:

Dates: Sunday November 30 - Saturday December 6 2025

Venue: Camp Getaway Axedale (transport from Melbourne provided)

Costs: The cost of this program is subsidised by Rotary sponsorship. The cost for the candidate will be \$50 with the remaining \$950 being paid by the sponsoring Rotary Club. If the candidate is experiencing financial hardship whereby \$50 will be a barrier, the club may pay this on the candidate's behalf.
